ORDINANCE CLOSING AND ABANDONING AND/OR ΑN DISCLAIMING AN UNOPENED AND UNIMPROVED PORTION OF THE PALMETTO STREET RIGHT-OF-WAY, AS REFLECTED ON THE PLAT OF MAXVILLE, RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 6, PAGE 78 AND AS SHOWN ON THE PLAT OF MAXVILLE FARMS, RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 4, PAGE 9, BOTH OF THE CURRENT PUBLIC RECORDS OF DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA, AND CLOSING AND ABANDONING AND/OR DISCLAIMING AN UNOPENED AND UNIMPROVED PORTION OF THE CAROLINA AVENUE RIGHT-OF-WAY, AS REFLECTED ON THE PLAT OF MAXVILLE FARMS, RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 4, PAGE 9 OF THE CURRENT PUBLIC RECORDS OF DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA, IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 12, AT THE REQUEST OF DENNIS HORNE, SUBJECT TO RESERVATION UNTO JEA AN ALL UTILITIES, FACILITIES AND ACCESS EASEMENT AND RESERVATION UNTO THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE OF A DRAINAGE EASEMENT; PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Closure and Abandonment. An unopened and unimproved portion of the Palmetto Street right-of-way reflected on the Plat of Maxwell, Fla., recorded in Plat Book 6, page 78 and as shown on the Plat of Maxville Farms, recorded in Plat Book 4, Page

9, both of the current public records of Duval County, Florida, and an unopened and unimproved portion of the Carolina Avenue right-ofway as shown on the Plat of Maxville Farms, recorded in Plat Book 4, Page 9 of the current public records of Duval County, Florida, located in Council District 12, a description and depiction of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by this reference, are hereby closed and abandoned and/or disclaimed as rights-of-way at the request of Dennis Horne (the "Applicant"); provided however, there is reserved unto JEA an all utilities, facilities and access easement on, over, under, through and across the closure areas for ingress and egress and for all utilities and facilities, including but not limited to, water, sewer and electric, so as to provide JEA continued access to repair and maintain these utilities and facilities, and further provided that a drainage easement on, over, under, through and across the closed rights-ofway areas shall be reserved in favor of the City of Jacksonville.

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The Applicant paid two right-of-way closure application fees of \$2,091.00 (for a total of \$4,182.00) and the closure and abandonment with encroachment fee of \$516.00, both of which have been deposited into the General Fund. These closure requests were reviewed and approved by the various city, state, and utility agencies that might have an interest in the right-of-way and there were no objections to the Applicant's request.

Section 2. Purpose. The Applicant owns property adjacent to the closure areas at 18208 Ware Avenue (R.E. No. 001021-0080) and is requesting the closures to incorporate the right-of-way closure areas into his residential property for personal use, subject to the conditions set forth herein.

Section 3. Hold Harmless Covenant. The closure and abandonment by the City of its interests in the subject portions of the Palmetto Street and Carolina Avenue rights-of-way is subject to

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Applicant's execution and delivery to the City of a Hold Harmless Covenant, in substantially the same form attached hereto as **Exhibit** 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. Accordingly, the closure and abandonment of these rights-of-way shall not be recorded in the public records until execution and delivery to the City by the Applicant of the required Hold Harmless Covenant.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
