AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$2,773,762.00 FROM THE NUISANCE ABATEMENT LIEN SPECIAL REVENUE FUND PURSUANT TO SECTION 111.470, ORDINANCE CODE, ALLOCATING \$1,359,143.38 TO THE NEIGHBORHOODS DEPARTMENT, MUNICIPAL CODE COMPLIANCE DIVISION, AND THE BALANCE OF \$1,414,618.62 TO THE PUBLIC DEPARTMENT, MOWING AND WORKS LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE DIVISION TO BE SPLIT BETWEEN MOWING AND LANDSCAPE - PRIVATE PROPERTY (\$990,233.00) AND MOWING AND LANDSCAPE - TREE REMOVAL (\$424,385.62), TO PROCURE NUISANCE ABATEMENT CONTRACTUAL SERVICES FOR THE REMOVAL OF PROPERTY CODE VIOLATIONS THROUGHOUT THE CITY ΙN COMPLIANCE WITH CHAPTER 518, ORDINANCE CODE, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 22-107; AMENDING SECTION 111.470 (NUISANCE ABATEMENT LIEN SPECIAL REVENUE FUND), PART 4 (ADMINISTRATION, PERSONNEL AND CODE REGULATION), CHAPTER 111 (SPECIAL REVENUE AND TRUST ACCOUNTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT FUNDS DEPOSITED IN THE NUISANCE ABATEMENT LIEN SPECIAL REVENUE FUND SHALL BE SELF-APPROPRIATING AND DESIGNATING HOW FUNDS SHALL BE DIVIDED BETWEEN THE NEIGHBORHOODS DEPARTMENT AND THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING THE ABATEMENT OF NUISANCES; PROVIDING

CODIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above comprises available revenues from the Nuisance Abatement Lien Special Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 111.470, Ordinance Code, that will be used for nuisance abatement contractual services.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for nuisance abatement contractual services for the removal of property code violations throughout the city in accordance with Chapter 518, Ordinance Code. A total of \$1,359,143.38 is allocated to the Neighborhoods Department, Municipal Code Compliance Division, and the remaining \$1,414,618.62 is allocated to the Public Works Department, Mowing and Landscape Maintenance Division to be split between Mowing and Landscape - Private Property (\$990,233.00) and Mowing and Landscape - Tree Removal (\$424,385.62), for the procurement of these contractual services.

Section 3. Amending Section 111.470 (Nuisance Abatement Lien Special Revenue Fund), Part 4 (Administration, Personnel and

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Code Regulation), Chapter 111 (Special Revenue and Trust Accounts),

Ordinance Code. Section 111.470 (Nuisance Abatement Lien Special

Revenue Fund), Part 4 (Administration, Personnel and Code

Regulations), Chapter 111 (Special Revenue and Trust Accounts),

Ordinance Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 111 - SPECIAL REVENUE AND TRUST ACCOUNTS

* * *

PART 4. - ADMINISTRATION, PERSONNEL AND CODE REGULATION

Sec. 111.470. - Nuisance Abatement Lien Special Revenue Fund.

There is hereby created the Nuisance Abatement Lien Special Revenue Fund, a permanent fund of the City within the Neighborhoods Department, into which monies derived from the collection of liens pursuant to Sections 518.211 (payment and enforcement of lien and interest thereon), 518.308 (demolition liens), and 91.107 and 91.112 (administrative liens), Ordinance Code, and other civil penalties collected pursuant to the citation and enforcement authority contained in Part 2 of Chapter 518, Ordinance Code, resulting from the City's prosecution of nuisances, shall be deposited from timeto-time. Disbursements from this fund by Council shall be limited to funding the abatement of nuisances. Such monies as are deposited in this fund are to be self-appropriating and shall be divided amongst the Neighborhoods Department, Municipal Code Compliance Division (49%), and the Public Works Department, Mowing and Landscape Maintenance Division (51%), and shall be used solely for the purpose of funding the abatement of nuisances. The monies deposited in this fund shall not lapse at the end of any fiscal year and shall remain available for expenditure for the purposes set forth herein. No later than December 31 annually, the Director of the Neighborhoods Department and the Director of the Public Works Department, or their respective designees, shall each provide a report of revenues,

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expenditures, and abatements for their respective Departments for the prior fiscal year to City Council and the Council Auditor.

Codification Instructions. The Codifier and the Section 4. Office of General Counsel are authorized to make all chapter and division "table of contents" consistent with the changes set forth herein, including renumbering of sections. Such editorial changes and any other changes necessary to make the Ordinance Code consistent with the intent of this legislation are approved and directed herein, and the changes to the Ordinance Code shall be made forthwith and when inconsistencies are discovered.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
