12 AND THE BALANCE OF \$1,414,618.62 TO THE PUBLIC
13 WORKS DEPARTMENT, MOWING AND LANDSCAPE
14 MAINTENANCE DIVISION TO BE SPLIT BETWEEN MOWING
15 AND LANDSCAPE - PRIVATE PROPERTY (\$990,233.00)
16 AND MOWING AND LANDSCAPE - TREE REMOVAL
17 (\$424,385.62), TO PROCURE NUISANCE ABATEMENT
18 CONTRACTUAL SERVICES FOR THE REMOVAL OF PROPERTY
19 CODE VIOLATIONS THROUGHOUT THE CITY IN
20 COMPLIANCE WITH CHAPTER 518, *ORDINANCE CODE*, AS
21 INITIATED BY B.T. 22-107; AMENDING SECTION
22 111.470 (NUISANCE ABATEMENT LIEN SPECIAL REVENUE
23 FUND), PART 4 (ADMINISTRATION, PERSONNEL AND
24 CODE REGULATION), CHAPTER 111 (SPECIAL REVENUE
25 AND TRUST ACCOUNTS), *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO PROVIDE
26 THAT FUNDS DEPOSITED IN THE NUISANCE ABATEMENT
27 LIEN SPECIAL REVENUE FUND SHALL BE SELF-
28 APPROPRIATING AND DESIGNATING HOW FUNDS SHALL BE
29 DIVIDED BETWEEN THE NEIGHBORHOODS DEPARTMENT AND
30 THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF
31 FUNDING THE ABATEMENT OF NUISANCES; PROVIDING

CODIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS; PROVIDING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2021-2022 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above comprises available revenues from the Nuisance Abatement Lien Special Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 111.470, *Ordinance Code*, that will be used for nuisance abatement contractual services.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for nuisance abatement contractual services for the removal of property code violations throughout the city in accordance with Chapter 518, *Ordinance Code*. A total of \$1,359,143.38 is allocated to the Neighborhoods Department, Municipal Code Compliance Division, and the remaining \$1,414,618.62 is allocated to the Public Works Department, Mowing and Landscape Maintenance Division to be split between Mowing and Landscape - Private Property (\$990,233.00) and Mowing and Landscape - Tree Removal (\$424,385.62), for the procurement of these contractual services.

Section 3. Amending Section 111.470 (Nuisance Abatement Lien Special Revenue Fund), Part 4 (Administration, Personnel and

2 **Ordinance Code.** Section 111.470 (Nuisance Abatement Lien Special
3 Revenue Fund), Part 4 (Administration, Personnel and Code
4 Regulations), Chapter 111 (Special Revenue and Trust Accounts),
5 *Ordinance Code*, is hereby amended to read as follows:

8 **PART 4. - ADMINISTRATION, PERSONNEL AND CODE REGULATION**

10 **Sec. 111.470. - Nuisance Abatement Lien Special Revenue Fund.**

11 There is hereby created the Nuisance Abatement Lien Special
12 Revenue Fund, a permanent fund of the City within the Neighborhoods
13 Department, into which monies derived from the collection of liens
14 pursuant to Sections 518.211 (payment and enforcement of lien and
15 interest thereon), 518.308 (demolition liens), and 91.107 and 91.112
16 (administrative liens), Ordinance Code, and other civil penalties
17 collected pursuant to the citation and enforcement authority
18 contained in Part 2 of Chapter 518, Ordinance Code, resulting from
19 the City's prosecution of nuisances, shall be deposited from time-
20 to-time. ~~Disbursements from this fund by Council shall be limited to~~
21 ~~funding the abatement of nuisances.~~ Such monies as are deposited in
22 this fund are to be self-appropriating and shall be divided amongst
23 the Neighborhoods Department, Municipal Code Compliance Division
24 (49%), and the Public Works Department, Mowing and Landscape
25 Maintenance Division (51%), and shall be used solely for the purpose
26 of funding the abatement of nuisances. The monies deposited in this
27 fund shall not lapse at the end of any fiscal year and shall remain
28 available for expenditure for the purposes set forth herein. No later
29 than December 31 annually, the Director of the Neighborhoods
30 Department and the Director of the Public Works Department, or their
31 respective designees, shall each provide a report of revenues,

1 expenditures, and abatements for their respective Departments for the
2 prior fiscal year to City Council and the Council Auditor.

3 **Section 4. Codification Instructions.** The Codifier and the
4 Office of General Counsel are authorized to make all chapter and
5 division "table of contents" consistent with the changes set forth
6 herein, including renumbering of sections. Such editorial changes
7 and any other changes necessary to make the *Ordinance Code* consistent
8 with the intent of this legislation are approved and directed herein,
9 and the changes to the *Ordinance Code* shall be made forthwith and
10 when inconsistencies are discovered.

11 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall
12 become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming
13 effective without the Mayor's signature.
