AN ORDINANCE CLOSING AND ABANDONING AND/OR DISCLAIMING AN OPENED AND IMPROVED PORTION OF THE OAKLAWN PLACE RIGHT-OF-WAY, ESTABLISHED IN THE PLAT OF SAN BONITA, AS RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 12, PAGE 67 OF THE CURRENT PUBLIC RECORDS OF DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA, IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 5, AT THE REQUEST OF JODY BRANDENBURG, PRESIDENT OF OAKLAWN CEMETERY, SUBJECT TO RESERVATION UNTO JEA OF AN ALL UTILITIES, FACILITIES AND ACCESS EASEMENT AND RESERVATION UNTO THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE OF A DRAINAGE EASEMENT; PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Closure and Abandonment. An opened and improved portion of the Oaklawn Place right-of-way, established in the Plat of San Bonita, as recorded in Plat Book 12, Page 67 of the current public records of Duval County, Florida, located in Council District 5, a depiction and description of which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby closed and abandoned and/or disclaimed as a right-of-way at the request of Jody Brandenburg, as President and on behalf of, Oaklawn Cemetery (the "Applicant"); provided however, there is reserved unto JEA an all utilities, facilities and access easement on, over, under, through and across the closed right-of-way for ingress and egress and for all utilities and facilities, including but not limited to, water, sewer

and electric, so as to provide JEA continued access to repair and maintain these utilities and facilities, and there is further reserved unto the City of Jacksonville a drainage easement on, over, under, through and across the right-of-way closure area. The Applicant paid the right-of-way closure application fee of \$2,091.00 and this amount has been deposited into the General Fund. This closure request was reviewed and approved by the various city, state, and utility agencies that might have an interest in the right-of-way and there were no objections to the Applicant's request.

Section 2. Purpose. Oaklawn Cemetery, whose interests the Applicant represents as President of that entity, owns property adjacent to the closure area at 4801 San Jose Boulevard (R.E. No. 099288-0000) and is requesting the closure in order to construct a grand entrance to the Legacy Lodge owned by Oaklawn Cemetery, subject to the conditions set forth herein.

abandonment by the City of its interests in the right-of-way is subject to Applicant's execution and delivery to the City of a Hold Harmless Covenant, in substantially the same form attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference. Accordingly, the closure and abandonment of the right-of-way shall not be recorded in the public records until execution and delivery to the City by the Applicant of the required Hold Harmless Covenant.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
