RESOLUTION 2022-738-A

A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING GEORGE BANKS ON HIS YEARS OF SERVICE TO THE CAUSE OF INTERNATIONAL UNDERSTANDING AND FELLOWSHIP; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, George Banks, a U.S. Navy veteran, has had a long and distinguished career as a broadcast journalist, first as an awardwinning television reporter in Syracuse, New York and Springfield, Massachusetts, later in Jacksonville producing and hosting a program on international issues for 20 years on Comcast cable television, and most recently hosting a weekly classical music radio program on Flagler College Radio; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Banks served a term on the Jacksonville City Council in the late 1990s representing Council District 5, and was twice honored with the Charles Webb Award (once individually and once as a member of the Council as a Whole) by the Council President as the most effective council member; and

WHEREAS, following his Council service, George Banks was named as the City of Jacksonville's first and only International Director, leading the City's efforts in the area of international relations both domestically and abroad; and

WHEREAS, in that role he participated in the creation of the Mayor's Hispanic American Advisory Board and the Mayor's Asian American Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, he facilitated the activities of numerous international delegations visiting Jacksonville and worked with the

Sister Cities organization and other agencies promoting international relations to send Jacksonville delegations abroad; and

WHEREAS, in his role as International Director for the City he participated in numerous city and state international cultural and trade missions to destinations ranging from Seoul and Masan, South Korea to Santiago, Chile and from Beijing, China to Sao Paolo, Brazil, carrying the message of Jacksonville's readiness to participate in the international economy and to share educational, cultural, and tourism links with countries and peoples around the world; and

WHEREAS, George Banks has been honored in both of his careers, having been a recipient of the Valley Forge Freedom Foundation Award for a victims rights documentary he produced and two Best Reporting awards from the Syracuse Press Club, and being awarded the Hy Kliman Global Connectivity Award by the Florida Coastal School of Law for his many international activities; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Banks, a longtime supporter of the American Legion, the Greater Jacksonville Area USO, and the Jacksonville Symphony, is still actively involved in the promotion and facilitation of international activities and relations through his consulting business - The Facilitators, Inc.; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City Council hereby honors and commends former City Council Member George Banks for his decades of dedicated and effective service in the cause of promoting, encouraging, and facilitating Jacksonville's involvement in international relations around the world as a means of promoting greater understanding among peoples and of helping to give Jacksonville a presence on the international stage. His trips around the world representing Jacksonville and his hosting and facilitation of scores of international delegations visiting our city have made connections and established friendships that continue to stand the city in good stead

as a player on the international stage. The City Council expresses its gratitude for all his hard work over the course of several decades and extends its best wishes for continued health, happiness, and productivity in the years to come.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
