**Bill Summary:** This bill closes and abandons an opened and improved portion of the Acosta Street right-of-way established in the Howell Subdivision Plat, as recorded in Plat Book 1, Page 130 of the former public records of Duval County, Florida, located in Council District 9. An easement over the entire closure area will be reserved in the name of the City of Jacksonville and JEA. No City, State, or other agency objected to this closure request.

**Background Information:** The purpose of this legislation is to permit the applicant, Florida Mechanical Systems, Inc., to close the area to minimize traffic into its industrial site and secure the site with a gate.

Policy Impact Area: Closure/Abandonment of Right-of-Way, Howell Subdivision

Fiscal Impact: The applicant has paid the \$2,091 closure application fee.
