A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING NINA WATERS ON HER YEARS OF SERVICE TO THE JACKSONVILLE COMMUNITY AS SHE ANNOUNCES HER RETIREMENT FROM THE PRESIDENCY OF THE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION FOR NORTHEAST FLORIDA; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, Nina Waters, a native of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, came to Jacksonville in 1976 to attend Jacksonville University and built an impressive professional career in the city following her graduation; and

WHEREAS, from 1989 to 2001 Ms. Waters was Executive Director of the PACE Center for Girls Jacksonville, where she completed a \$2.5 million capital campaign, assisted in the oversight of construction of a new 20,000 square foot facility and facilitated the relocation of the program to the Thompson-Weaver campus on University Boulevard North; and

WHEREAS, following her success at the PACE Center, Nina Waters joined the staff at the Community Foundation for Northeast Florida, Florida's oldest and largest community foundation, as Executive Vice President. After three years she was named President of the foundation and has served the organization splendidly in that capacity for nearly 18 years; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Waters' accomplishments at the Community Foundation are numerous and substantial. She launched the Quality Education for All initiative in 2005, which led to the creation of the Jacksonville Public Education Fund and culminated in the announcement of a \$50 million fund for local education investment. She also assisted in the development of the Women's Giving Alliance, the Foundation's first giving circle, the LGBTQ Community Fund for Northeast Florida and the A. L. Lewis Black Opportunity & Impact Fund. The Community Foundation's assets have grown more than ten-fold during her presidency and annual grants to the community have increased fivefold in that time, to more than \$43 million in 2021; and

7 WHEREAS, Nina Waters has also been deeply involved in 8 philanthropy, education, and community improvement in a variety of 9 other ways. A small sampling of her volunteerism and leadership 10 positions include membership on the governing boards of the Chamber of Commerce, the 11 Jacksonville Nemours Foundation, 12 Jacksonville University and the JU Public Policy Institute, the Jacksonville Civic Council, the Uptown Civitan Club and the Women's 13 Giving Alliance Steering Committee. She is a Past Chair of the 14 Southeastern Council of Foundations and had been a board member of 15 Center for Family Philanthropy, 16 the National the Florida 17 Philanthropic Network and Past-President of Community Foundations of Florida; and 18

WHEREAS, Ms. Waters' outstanding work has been recognized by 19 20 numerous organizations. A very brief listing of her awards includes 21 induction into the First Coast Hall of Fame, the Florida Times-Union 22 EVE Award for Employment, The OneJax Institute Humanitarian Award, the Jacksonville University Distinguished Alumni Award, the Nonprofit 23 24 Center of Northeast Florida Sector Advocate Award, the Gateway Girl 25 Scout Council Woman of Distinction Award and the Prudential Foundation 26 Leadership Award; and

WHEREAS, Nina Waters has recently announced her intention to retire from the Presidency of the Community Foundation in 2023 after a long and distinguished career; now therefore
