ORDINANCE 2022-793

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CHAPTER 745 (ADDRESSING AND STREET NAMING REGULATIONS) ORDINANCE CODE; ESTABLISHING AN HONORARY STREET DESIGNATION AND ASSOCIATED ROADWAY MARKERS FOR FRED WILLIAM CALLAHAN; ESTABLISHING AN HONORARY STREET DESIGNATION ON MYRTLE AVENUE EXTENDING FROM 5TH STREET TO 6TH STREET IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 8 FOR WILLIAM CALLAHAN; PROVIDING FOR INSTALLATION OF TWO HONORARY ROADWAY MARKERS TO LOCATED IN APPROPRIATE LOCATIONS ON THE DESIGNATED ROAD IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 8; WAIVER OF SECTION 745.105 (I)(2) WHICH REQUIRES THAT THE HONOREE BE DECEASED FOR AT LEAST FIVE (5) YEARS; WAIVER OF SECTION 745.105 (I) (3) WHICH REQUIRES THAT THE HONOREE RESIDE IN THE COMMUNITY WITHIN FIVE (5) MILES OF THE DESIGNATED STREET FOR AT LEAST 10 YEARS; DIRECTING THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES DIVISION TO FORWARD THIS ORDINANCE TO THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT FOR PROCESSING AND COORDINATION WITH THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, TRAFFIC ENGINEERING AND OTHER AFFECTED AGENCIES AND ORGANIZATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Fred William Callahan lived and operated several successful businesses in Jacksonville before he passed in 2019; and WHEREAS, Fred William Callahan served as a proud and decorated member of the United States Marines participating in combat in the WHEREAS, as an enlisted United States Marine, Mr. Callahan served as a distinguished Green Beret and served a complete tour; and WHEREAS, Mr. Callahan was medically discharged and started a successful business known as Skinner's Florist located in Jacksonville at 1519 Myrtle Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Fred William Callahan was a proud father; and
WHEREAS, Mr. Callahan's family continue operating Skinner's
Florist as a successful and thriving business; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Callahan also worked as a major concert promoter where he was able to book such well-known artists as Gladys Knight, Patti Labelle, The Temptations, Teddy Pendergrass, and Bobby Womack; and

WHEREAS, Fred William Callahan's legacy still exists via his children who are college-educated and successful business owners; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 745.105 (j)(10), Ordinance Code, the Planning and Development Department mailed written notifications on May 13, 2022, and on September 1, 2022, to affected property owners requesting the affected property owners to indicate their written consent or objection to the proposed honorary street designation. Copies of the letters are attached as Exhibit 1 and Exhibit 2; and

WHEREAS, initially, a majority of the affected property owners indicated their written objections to the proposed honorary designation. Copies of the completed Honorary Designation Form are attached as Exhibit 3; and

WHEREAS, one affected property owner consented to the proposed honorary designation. A copy of the written consent is attached as Exhibit 4; and

WHEREAS, several affected property owners issued a written "retraction" of their previous objections to the proposed honorary designation. Copies of the "retractions" are attached as Exhibit 5;

and

WHEREAS, the applicant has remitted funds to satisfy the cost
for the honorary markers (See attached Exhibit 6); and

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Myrtle Avenue to receive an honorary street designation for Fred William Callahan. "Myrtle Avenue" extending from 5th Street to 6th Street in Council District 8, is hereby designated as contemplated by Section 745.105, Ordinance Code, for Fred William Callahan. A map of the road designation is attached hereto as Exhibit 7.

Section 2. Honorary Roadside Markers for Fred William Callahan to be installed. Two honorary roadside markers, as contemplated by Section 745.105, Ordinance Code, recognizing and honoring Fred William Callahan shall be placed in appropriate locations on Myrtle Avenue.

Section 3. Waiver of Section 745.105 (i)(2), Ordinance Code. Section 745.105(i)(2) which requires that the honoree be deceased for at least five (5) years is hereby waived to honor Mr. Callahan now for his contributions to the community by running a floral business in the community.

Section 4. Waiver of Section 745. 105 (i)(3), Ordinance Code. Section 745.105 (i)(3), which requires that the honoree reside in the community within five (5) miles of the designated street for at least 10 years is hereby waived because Mr Callahan owned and operated Skinner Florists which is located on the designated road.

Section 5. Directing Legislative Services Division to forward a copy to the Planning and Development Department. The Chief of Legislative Services is requested to send a copy of this legislation, once enacted, to the Planning and Development Department, Addressing Unit, for processing, implementation, and coordination with the Public Works Department, Traffic Engineering
