Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery ("CDBG-DR") funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"), through the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity, originally appropriated by Ordinance 2022-165-E for forgivable loans, to allocate said funds for salaries and benefits for four full-time equivalent (FTE) positions within the CDBG-DR program.
