**Bill Summary:** The bill confirms the Mayor's reappointment of Karen Feagins as a member of the Art in Public Places Committee, as a representative of the Cultural Council of Greater Jacksonville, Inc., for a first full term to expire on December 31, 2024.

**Background Information:** The Art in Public Places Committee is established pursuant to Chapter 126, *Ordinance Code*, and charged to choose art which is compatible with and which will enhance the architecture and general environment of the City; receive, review and act on the recommendations of the Art Selection Panels; seek to ensure that at least 15% of the artists selected for purchase or commission will be resident(s) in the Greater Jacksonville area (Duval, St. Johns, Nassau, Clay and Baker Counties); and also encourage the selection of regional artists e.g. Florida and the Southeastern United States. Section 126.903, *Ordinance Code*, provides that the 11 members of the committee are appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council, with two of the members representing the Cultural Council Board.

Karen Feagins is the VP, Client and Community Relations Director at PNC Financial Services and she has been in that role since March 2018. Ms. Feagins has a bachelor's degree in Journalism from the University of Missouri. Ms. Feagins is a Duval County resident and lives in Council District 5.

**Attendance:** Ms. Feagins' attendance record is 94%, she attended 15 of 16 meetings during her term from 8/11/2020 to 12/31/2021.
