ΑN ORDINANCE CONCERNING CHAPTER 173 (CEMETERIES), ORDINANCE CODE; AMENDING SECTION 173.111 (EXEMPTION), ORDINANCE CODE, TO EXEMPT CHURCH CEMETERIES OF LESS THAN FIVE ACRES THAT PROVIDE ONLY SINGLE-LEVEL GROUND BURIAL AND CHURCH MAUSOLEUMS CONSISTING OF TWO ACRES OR LESS FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 173.103, ORDINANCE CODE, AND DELETING THE EXISTING EXEMPTION FROM SECTION 173.105(H), ORDINANCE CODE; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

whereas, Section 173.111, Ordinance Code, provides an exemption for columbarium of a certain type and size that are owned by and immediately adjacent to a church facility from the requirements of Sections 173.103 and 173.105(h), Ordinance Code, which provide that cemeteries must be platted and a landscape buffer installed along any cemetery boundary line which adjoins property zoned for residential use; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance expands the exemption from the platting requirements of Section 173.103, Ordinance Code, to cemeteries and mausoleums of a certain type and size that are owned by and immediately contiguous to a church facility and deletes the exemption from the landscape buffer requirements; and

WHEREAS, the types of burial/interment facilities contemplated

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in this Ordinance are also exempt from a number of the requirements of Chapter 497, Florida Statutes, which provides various regulations for cemeteries and other types of burial facilities; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance does not exempt the columbarium, cemeteries, and mausoleums described below from any applicable requirements of Florida Statutes or the provisions of Chapter 173, Ordinance Code, except as specifically provided herein; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Amending Section 173.111 (Exemption), Chapter 173 (Cemeteries), Ordinance Code. Section 173.111 (Exemption), Chapter 173 (Cemeteries), Ordinance Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

## CHAPTER 173 - CEMETERIES

\* \* \*

## Sec. 173.111. - Exemption.

<u>Section</u>Sections 173.103 and 173.105(h) of this Chapter shall not apply to:

- (a) Aa columbarium consisting of less than one-half acre which is owned by and immediately contiguous to a church facility which is in existence at the time the columbarium is being built. The location of the columbarium shall, however, be subject to local government zoning. If the church relocates, the church shall relocate all of the urns and remains placed in the columbarium which were placed therein during its use by the church.
- (b) A church cemetery of less than five acres which provides only single-level ground burial.
- (c) A mausoleum consisting of two acres or less which is

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owned by and immediately contiguous to an existing church facility. The church establishing such a mausoleum must ensure that the mausoleum is kept and maintained in an orderly manner and limit its availability to members of the church. The church establishing such a mausoleum must have been incorporated for at least 25 years and must have sufficient funds in an endowment fund to cover the costs of construction of the mausoleum.

(d) The location of any church columbarium, cemetery, or mausoleum exempt under this Section shall, however, be subject to local government zoning.

For the purpose of this Section, church has the same meaning as defined in Section 656.1601656.102.

Section 2. Codification Instructions. The Codifier and the Office of General Counsel are authorized to make all chapter and division "tables of contents" consistent with the changes set forth herein. Such editorial changes and any others necessary to make the Ordinance Code consistent with the intent of this legislation are approved and directed herein, and changes to the Ordinance Code shall be made forthwith and when inconsistencies are discovered.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
