7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$394,136.00 IN GRANT  
8 FUNDING FOR YEAR TWO OF A FIVE-YEAR GRANT FROM  
9 THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES  
10 FOR THE DUVAL COUNTY FAMILY TREATMENT DRUG COURT  
11 ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM, AS INITIATED BY REVISED  
12 B.T. 23-006; PROVIDING FOR A CARRYOVER OF FUNDS  
13 TO SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEARS; PROVIDING AN  
14 EFFECTIVE DATE.

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16 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

17 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,  
18 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
19 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
20 listed in subsection (b):

28 (c) **Explanation of Appropriation:**

29 The funding above is a SAMHSA grant from the U.S.  
30 Department of Health and Human Services approved for the  
31 Duval County Family Treatment Drug Court Enhancement

1 program. This appropriation is comprised of funds awarded  
2 for year two of the five-year grant and covers the period  
3 beginning May 31, 2020 through May 30, 2021. No City match  
4 is required.

5 **Section 2. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in Section 1  
6 of this Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover into subsequent  
7 fiscal years. The grantor allows funds to be carried over through a  
8 waiver that can be requested by the Courts in the event grant funds  
9 are not expended in the current fiscal year and are anticipated to  
10 be spent in the next fiscal year.

11 **Section 3. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
12 Section 1 is to provide additional funds for the Duval County Family  
13 Treatment Drug Court Enhancement program. The funding will be used  
14 to expand the collaborative delivery system of population focused  
15 care between the Courts and local community-based care agencies. The  
16 funds will allow the Courts to implement evidence-based treatment  
17 modalities to 40 unduplicated participants annually, with a goal of  
18 serving 200 participants during the five-year grant period. In  
19 addition, funding will be used to increase available bed days for  
20 adult residential treatment, increase the use of medication-assisted  
21 treatment, and provide random, observed drug and alcohol testing.  
22 Intense substance abuse/mental health treatment services and case  
23 management will also be provided with various support services.  
24 Staffing will be provided through current staff members. A copy of  
25 the Notice of Award is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated  
26 herein by this reference.

27 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
28 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
29 without the Mayor's signature.
