ORDINANCE ΑN APPROPRIATING \$268,355.00 (\$203,846.00 IN GRANT FUNDS FROM AMERICORPS SENIORS, FORMERLY KNOWN AS THE CORPORATION FOR NATIONAL AND COMMUNITY SERVICE, AND A \$64,509.00 MATCH FROM THE CITY FROM GENERAL FUND OPERATING FUND BALANCE) FOR THE DUVAL COUNTY SENIOR COMPANION PROGRAM, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 22-111; AUTHORIZING POSITION AND PART-TIME HOURS, AS INITIATED BY R.C. 22-169; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE SENIOR SERVICES DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above comprises \$203,846.00 in grant funds (the "Grant") from AmeriCorps Seniors (formerly known as the Corporation for National and Community Service) ("AmeriCorps") and an additional appropriation of \$64,509.00 from General Fund Operating Fund Balance for the City match, for the Duval County Senior Companion Program (the "Program"). The Grant period commences July 1, 2021 and ends June 30, 2024. This appropriation represents funding for year two of the Grant.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide grant funding for year two of the three year Grant to support the Program which focuses on providing aid and friendship to older adults who have difficulty with daily living tasks by connecting eligible seniors with Program volunteers. The Program serves seniors aged 60 years and older who have one or more physical, emotional, or mental health limitations and who need assistance to achieve and maintain a higher level of independent living. Volunteers perform tasks such as shopping, paying bills, and providing escorted services to medical appointments and other places as needed, while also providing companionship, which is intended to assist seniors to live independently in their homes for as long as possible, with the same or an improved quality of life.

The Grant and matching funds will be used for Program staff salary and benefits, volunteer stipends, meals and mileage, volunteer recognition events, supplies, training and travel. The Notice of Grant Award is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 3. Approval of Position. There is hereby approved the position and part-time hours more fully described in R.C. 22-169,

attached hereto as **Exhibit 3** and incorporated herein by this 1 2 reference. Oversight Department. 3 Section 4. The Senior Services Division of the Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Services 4 shall oversee administration of the Grant and shall provide oversight 5 of the Program and position described herein. 6 7 Section 5.
