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**ORDINANCE 2022-875** 

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THAT CERTAIN TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT ("EASEMENT") BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE ("CITY") AND JACKSONVILLE HISTORIC NAVAL SHIP ASSOCIATION, INC. ("COMPANY"), FOR A TERM OF FOUR (4) MONTHS, OVER APPROXIMATELY 4.5 ACRES OF CITY-OWNED SUBMERGED LANDS AND PIER ONE LOCATED ON THE WESTERLY BOUNDARY OF THE PROPERTY GENERALLY THE SHIPYARDS, TO ALLOW FOR KNOWN AS INSTALLATION BY COMPANY AT ITS EXPENSE OF EIGHT MOORING BOLLARDS AND THREE MOORING DOLPHINS AS NECESSARY TO SUPPORT THE MOORING OF THE USS ORLECK AT THAT LOCATION, AS FURTHER DETAILED IN THE EASEMENT; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; REQUESTING ONE-CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Temporary Construction Easement approved and execution authorized. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, that certain Temporary Construction Easement between the City of Jacksonville ("City"), and Jacksonville Historic Naval Ship Association, Inc. ("Company"), in substantially the same form placed On File with the Office of Legislative Services (the

"Easement"). The Easement is for a term of four (4) months, to allow for the construction by the Company of mooring bollards and mooring dolphins (the "Improvements") as necessary to support the mooring of the USS Orleck at the site.

Section 2. Oversight. The Department of Public Works shall oversee the project described herein.

Section 3. Requesting One-Cycle Emergency Passage pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the USS Orleck is currently moored adjacent to City Riverwalk on the Northbank and needs to be relocated to a permanent location.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
