The Department of Parks, Recreation, and Community Services applied for and was awarded \$1 million dollars from the Florida Department of State's African American Cultural & Historical (AACH) grant program to undergo a Park Redesign for James Weldon Johnson Park. The matching funds consist of \$250,000 that have already been allocated in the adopted CIP for FY22/23. This Redesign project will involve extensive community engagement, will provide construction documents, and pay for the first phase of construction—which is expected to include demo of existing failing infrastructure, dealing with the underground utilities, and grading. The initial grant period goes until June 1, 2023 but the grant administrators have confirmed that extensions will be granted until at least June 1, 2024. PRCS intends to use the continuing contractor for Parks design/build projects, ACON Construction Co., for this project. The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will create an unnecessary delay the construction of this recreational infrastructure. African American Cultural & Historical Grant @ James Weldon Johnson Park White Paper

October 31, 2022

Background

The Department of Parks, Recreation, and Community Services applied for and was awarded \$1 million dollars from the Florida Department of State's African American Cultural & Historical (AACH) grant program to undergo a Park Redesign for James Weldon Johnson Park. The matching funds consist of \$250,000 that have already been allocated in the adopted CIP for FY22/23.

This Redesign project will involve extensive community engagement, will provide construction documents, and pay for the first phase of construction—which is expected to include demo of existing failing infrastructure, dealing with the underground utilities, and grading.

The initial grant period goes until June 1, 2023 but the grant administrators have confirmed that extensions will be granted until at least June 1, 2024.

PRCS intends to use the continuing contractor for Parks design/build projects, ACON Construction Co., for this project.

Recommended Action

The Department of Parks, Recreation, and Community Services requests a one-cycle emergency legislation to execute the grant contract in order for the project to commence and use the continuing design/build contract with ACON Construction for the work.
