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ORDINANCE 2022-869

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A TRANSFER AND MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY JACKSONVILLE AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ("FDOT") PROVIDING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR FDOT'S CONSTRUCTION OF VARIOUS IMPROVEMENTS TO ROADS AND INTERSECTIONS ON CITY ONWED AND MAINTAINED PROPERTY AND RIGHTS-OF-WAY PART OF THE I-95 WIDENING PROJECT WITH SUBSEQUENT TRANSFER OF CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS CONSTRUCTED ON BOTH CITY AND FDOT PROPERTY TO THE CITY FOR ONGOING OPERATION, MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Approval and Authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver the Transfer and Maintenance Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") in substantially the same form as is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Agreement"). The Agreement provides that FDOT will fund and construct various improvements to roads and intersections on both City and FDOT-owned property as part of the I-

95 widening project. The improvements will include construction of cul-de-sacs, curb and gutter, signage and pavement markings, construction of a diverging diamond interchange, installation of drainage pipes and structures, construction and widening of various ponds, and the addition of new lanes. The various locations for the improvements to City owned and maintained rights-of-way include, but are not limited to, portions of Belfort Road, Bowden Road, Spring Park Road, De Kalb Avenue, Abby Lane, Cactus Lane, Cooper Circle West, Rodney Lane, Taylor Street, Glen Mawr Road, and Merwyn Street. Upon completion of the project, improvements constructed on City owned and maintained property as well as improvements constructed on certain property currently owned and maintained by FDOT will be transferred to the City for ongoing operation, maintenance and repair at the City's sole cost and expense.

Section 2. Oversight Department. The Public Works

Department shall oversee administration of the Agreement and the project described herein.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
