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RESOLUTION 2022-882

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE COUNCIL'S SUPPORT FOR LOCAL BILL J-2, TO BE CONSIDERED BY THE DUVAL COUNTY LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION, WHICH WOULD AMEND CHAPTERS 87-471, LAWS OF FLORIDA, AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER 2011-255, 2016-248, 2017-213, AND 2022-259 LAWS OF FLORIDA, TO ADD A SPECIAL EVENT CENTER ZONE CALLED "DENNIS STREET COMMERCIAL CORRIDOR AREA" TO JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA, SO AS TO PROVIDE AN EXCEPTION TO \$561.20, FLORIDA STATUTES, FOR LIQUOR LICENSES FOR EVENT CENTERS WHICH HAVE AN OCCUPANT CAPACITY BETWEEN 2,100 AND 2,900 PEOPLE, AN OVERALL FLOOR CAPACITY BETWEEN 22,000 AND 35,000 SQUARE FEET, AND DERIVE NO LESS THAN 51 PERCENT OF ANNUAL GROSS INCOME FROM SALE OF EVENT CENTER TICKETS AND FOOD AND NONALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES THAT ARE PREPARED, SERVED, AND CONSUMED ON SUCH PREMISES WITHIN THE DENNIS STREET COMMERCIAL CORRIDOR; PROVIDING FOR ADVERTISING REQUIREMENTS FOR LOCAL PROPONENTS; DIRECTING THE DUVAL DELEGATION COORDINATOR TO FORWARD TO MUNICODE ANY STATE LAW CHANGE WHICH EFFECTUATES THIS REQUEST; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Support of Local Bill J-2. The Council hereby expresses its support of Local Bill J-2, to be considered by the

Duval County Legislative Delegation, for the 2023 State Legislative Session. Said Local Bill J-2 would amend Chapter 87-471 Laws of Florida, as amended by Chapters 2011-255, 2016-248 and 2017-213 Laws of Florida, to create a new special zone for event centers in the Dennis Street Commercial Corridor Area in Jacksonville, Florida so as to provide an exception to \$561.20, Florida Statutes, for event centers which have an occupant capacity between 2,100 and 2,900 people, an overall floor capacity between 22,000 and 35,000 square feet, and derive no less than 51 percent of annual gross income from sale of event center tickets and food and nonalcoholic beverages that are prepared, served, and consumed on such premises within the Dennis Street Commercial Corridor. A true and correct copy of said Local Bill J-2 is attached hereto as Exhibit 1. A map depicting the area for the Dennis Street Commercial Corridor is attached to Exhibit 2.

Section 2. State J-bill process. The House of Representative sponsor will combine Exhibit 1 and Exhibit 2 into one J-bill to be delivered to House Bill Drafting. The respective local proponents will be responsible for complying with the provisions of the Local Bill Filing Manual including but not limited to advertising and public hearing requirements. The Duval Delegation Local Bill hearing will occur on January , 2023, in the City Council Chambers.

Section 3. Directing the Duval Delegation Coordinator to Forward to Municode any State Law Change which Effectuates this request. The Duval Delegation Coordinator is hereby directed to forward any state law change in the 2023 State Legislative Session that effectuates this request so that, if approved, the new law shall also be placed in Part B-Related Laws, of the Charter and Related Laws of the City of Jacksonville so that it can be catalogued with other changes affecting the City of Jacksonville approved by special act of the Legislature.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall become

effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
