Bill Summary: The bill authorizes execution of a Transfer and Maintenance Agreement between the City and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for I-95-related improvements on City property. The Public Works Department is designated as the City's oversight agency.

Background Information: As part of an upcoming I-95 widening project south of Atlantic Boulevard, the FDOT will fund and construct various improvements to roads and intersections, some of which are in City rights-of-way, including, but not limited to, portions of Belfort Road, Bowden Road, Spring Park Road, DeKalb Avenue, Cactus Lane, Cooper Circle West, Rodney Lane, Taylor Street, Glen Mawr Road and Merwin Street. Upon completion of the project the City will be responsible for the operation, maintenance and repair of the improvements. The improvements to be constructed include cul-de-sacs, curbs and gutters, signage and pavement markings, a diverging diamond interchange, drainage pipes and structure, additional travel lanes, and drainage retention ponds.
