**Bill Summary:** This bill confirms the Mayor's appointment of Ashley Folladori, a Duval County resident, to the Cultural Council of Greater Jacksonville, replacing Craig Shoup, pursuant to Section 118.602 (Responsibility), Part 6 (Cultural Service Grant Program), Chapter 118 (City Grant), *Ordinance Code*, for a partial term to expire on September 30, 2024.

**Background Information:** The Cultural Council of Greater Jacksonville is designated pursuant to Chapter 118, Part 6, *Ordinance Code*, as the agent of the City for the purposes of determining and authorizing the allocation of a lump sum Cultural Service Grant and Capital Grant appropriation designated in the annual budget ordinance or in supplemental appropriation ordinances as being appropriated for eligible recipients.

Section 118.602, *Ordinance Code*, provides that the membership of the council shall include six members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council.

Ms. Folladori holds a bachelor's degree in International Affairs from Florida State University. She is the Vice President of Public Affairs at JAX Chamber.
