7 A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF
8 LINDA F. MCCALLUM, A FORMER CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE
9 AND DUVAL COUNTY RESIDENT, AS A MEMBER OF THE
10 JACKSONVILLE ETHICS COMMISSION, PURSUANT TO
11 SECTION 602.912, *ORDINANCE CODE*, FOR A FIRST
12 FULL TERM TO EXPIRE DECEMBER 31, 2025; PROVIDING
13 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

15 **WHEREAS**, Resolution 2021-569-A confirmed the appointment of
16 Linda F. McCallum to the Jacksonville Ethics Commission, for an
17 initial partial term to expire December 31, 2022; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Section 602.912(a), *Ordinance Code*, provides that
19 initial terms on the Jacksonville Ethics Commission for less than two
20 years shall not be considered a full term for purposes of
21 reappointment; now therefore

22 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

23 **Section 1. Reappointment Confirmation.** The Council hereby
24 confirms the Chief Judge's reappointment of Linda F. McCallum, a
25 former Circuit Court judge and a Duval County resident, to the
26 Jacksonville Ethics Commission, pursuant to Section 602.912,
27 *Ordinance Code*, for a first full three-year term to expire December
28 31, 2025. Correspondence from the Chief Judge, Mark H. Mahon, is
29 attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**.

30 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
31 effective upon signature of the Mayor or upon becoming effective
