AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$962,212.30 FROM BUILDING INSPECTION FUND FUND BALANCE TO THE ED BALL BUILDING MAINTENANCE AND UPGRADES PROJECT "PROJECT") FOR VARIOUS UPDATES AND REPLACEMENTS IN THE ED BALL BUILDING, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 23-014; AMENDING THE 2023-2027 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2022-505-E TO REFLECT THIS APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO THE PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR REVERTER OF FUNDS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2022-2023 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(C) Explanation of Appropriation: The funding above represents an appropriation of funds from the Building Inspection Fund fund balance to the Ed Ball Building Maintenance and Upgrades project (the "Project") for various updates and replacements in the Ed Ball Building.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to pay for various updates and replacements in the Ed Ball Building. Specifically, these funds will be used to replace HVAC air handlers and to clean all related duct work on the second floor and the first-floor training room. In addition, the main customer entry doors on the second floor will be replaced with automatic accessible doors. These funds will also be used to install new chilled water piping, to replace carpet and vinyl laminate flooring on the second floor in the Building Inspection, Permitting, Development Services, Zoning and Addressing areas, and other improvements.

Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2022-505-E, adopting the 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reflect this additional funding for the Project in fiscal year 2022-2023 as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay completion of these necessary repairs and upgrades to the Ed Ball Building.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute

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an amendment to Ordinance 2022-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2022-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. Reverter. Any remaining funds after the completion of the Project shall be returned to the account of origin.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
