AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CHAPTER 745 (ADDRESSING 4 5 AND STREET NAMING REGULATIONS) ORDINANCE CODE; ESTABLISHING AN HONORARY STREET DESIGNATION AND 6 7 ASSOCIATED ROADWAY MARKERS FOR FRED WILLIAM 8 CALLAHAN; ESTABLISHING AN HONORARY STREET 9 DESIGNATION ON MYRTLE AVENUE EXTENDING FROM 5TH STREET TO 6TH STREET IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 8 FOR 10 11 FRED WILLIAM CALLAHAN; PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF TWO HONORARY ROADWAY MARKERS TO 12 13 LOCATED IN APPROPRIATE LOCATIONS ON THE BE DESIGNATED ROAD IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 8; WAIVER OF 14 15 SECTION 745.105 (I) (2) WHICH REQUIRES THAT THE 16 HONOREE BE DECEASED FOR AT LEAST FIVE (5) YEARS; 17 WAIVER OF SECTION 745.105 (I) (3) WHICH REQUIRES THAT THE HONOREE RESIDE IN THE COMMUNITY WITHIN 18 FIVE (5) MILES OF THE DESIGNATED STREET FOR AT 19 20 LEAST 10 YEARS; DIRECTING THE LEGISLATIVE 21 SERVICES DIVISION TO FORWARD THIS ORDINANCE TO 22 THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT FOR PROCESSING AND COORDINATION WITH THE PUBLIC 23 24 WORKS DEPARTMENT, TRAFFIC ENGINEERING AND OTHER 25 AFFECTED AGENCIES AND ORGANIZATIONS; PROVIDING 26 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

28 WHEREAS, Fred William Callahan lived and operated several 29 successful businesses in Jacksonville before he passed in 2019; and 30 WHEREAS, Fred William Callahan served as a proud and decorated 31 member of the United States Marines participating in combat in the Vietnam War; and

2 WHEREAS, as an enlisted United States Marine, Mr. Callahan 3 served as a distinguished Green Beret and served a complete tour; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Callahan was medically discharged and started a
successful business known as Skinner's Florist located in
Jacksonville at 1519 Myrtle Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Fred William Callahan was a proud father; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Callahan's family continue operating Skinner's 9 Florist as a successful and thriving business; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Callahan also worked as a major concert promoter where he was able to book such well-known artists as Gladys Knight, Patti Labelle, The Temptations, Teddy Pendergrass, and Bobby Womack; and

14 WHEREAS, Fred William Callahan's legacy still exists via his 15 children who are college-educated and successful business owners; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 745.105 (j)(10), Ordinance Code, the Planning and Development Department mailed written notifications on May 13, 2022, and on September 1, 2022, to affected property owners requesting the affected property owners to indicate their written consent or objection to the proposed honorary street designation. Copies of the letters are attached as Exhibit 1 and Exhibit 2; and

WHEREAS, initially, a majority of the affected property owners indicated their written objections to the proposed honorary designation. Copies of the completed Honorary Designation Form are attached as **Exhibit 3**; and

WHEREAS, one affected property owner consented to the proposed honorary designation. A copy of the written consent is attached as Exhibit 4; and

WHEREAS, several affected property owners issued a written "retraction" of their previous objections to the proposed honorary designation. Copies of the "retractions" are attached as Exhibit 5;

2 WHEREAS, the applicant has remitted funds to satisfy the cost 3 for the honorary markers (See attached **Exhibit 6**); and

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

5 Section 1. Myrtle Avenue to receive an honorary street 6 designation for Fred William Callahan. "Myrtle Avenue" extending from 7 5th Street to 6th Street in Council District 8, is hereby designated 8 as contemplated by Section 745.105, Ordinance Code, for Fred William 9 Callahan. A map of the road designation is attached hereto as **Exhibit** 10 7.

11 Section 2. Honorary Roadside Markers for Fred William 12 Callahan to be installed. Two honorary roadside markers, as 13 contemplated by Section 745.105, Ordinance Code, recognizing and 14 honoring Fred William Callahan shall be placed in appropriate 15 locations on Myrtle Avenue.

Section 3. Waiver of Section 745.105 (i)(2), Ordinance Code. Section 745.105(i)(2) which requires that the honoree be deceased for at least five (5) years is hereby waived to honor Mr. Callahan now for his contributions to the community by running a floral business in the community.

Section 4. Waiver of Section 745. 105 (i)(3), Ordinance Code. Section 745.105 (i)(3), which requires that the honoree reside in the community within five (5) miles of the designated street for at least 10 years is hereby waived because Mr Callahan owned and operated Skinner Florists which is located on the designated road.

26 Section 5. Directing Legislative Services Division to 27 forward a copy to the Planning and Development Department. The Chief 28 of Legislative Services is requested to send a copy of this 29 legislation, once enacted, to the Planning and Development 30 Department, Addressing Unit, for processing, implementation, and 31 coordination with the Public Works Department, Traffic Engineering

1 Division and other affected agencies and organizations.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
