AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CHAPTER 745 (ADDRESSING AND STREET NAMING REGULATIONS) ORDINANCE CODE;
TO RE-NAME "GATOR BOWL BOULEVARD" BEGINNING AT
A. PHILIP RANDOLPH BOULEVARD AND EXTENDING TO
COMMODORE POINT EXPRESSWAY AT THE BASE OF THE
HART BRIDGE AS "EAST BAY STREET"; DIRECTING THE
LEGISLATIVE SERVICES DIVISION TO FORWARD THIS
ORDINANCE TO THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT
DEPARTMENT AND THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT;
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department's Addressing Unit received an application to re-name a portion of Gator Bowl Blvd. as "East Bay Street"; and

WHEREAS, the applicant seeks to provide consistent downtown naming in anticipation for planned Bay Street corridor improvements including the development of waterfront parcels on East Bay Street; and

WHEREAS, the applicant has submitted the required payment for the street name change. The application and payment receipt are attached as Exhibit 1; and

WHEREAS, the Council seeks to re-name "Gator Bowl Boulevard" to
"East Bay Street"; and

WHEREAS, on August 19, 2022 and September 19, 2022, and pursuant to Section 745.105 (c), Ord. Code, the Planning and Development Department mailed notification letters to affected property owners

requesting their consent or objection to the proposed street renaming. Copies of the notification letters are attached as **Exhibit** 2 and **Exhibit 3**; and

WHEREAS, because the affected property owners failed to respond to the City's written notifications, such non-response is deemed as acceptance of the proposed street name change; and

WHEREAS, on October 5, 2022, the 911 Emergency Addressing Advisory Committee voted to accept the Staff Recommendation to rename "Gator Bowl Boulevard" to "East Bay Street". A copy of the minutes of the October 5, 2022, public meeting of the 911 Emergency Addressing Advisory Committee is attached as Exhibit 4; and

WHEREAS, on October 26, 2022, the Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission ("JHPC") voted to adopt the Staff Report with a recommendation for approval to re-name "Gator Bowl Boulevard" to "East Bay Street." A copy of the JHPC agenda, Staff Report, and the excerpt minutes of the October 26, 2022 public meeting of the Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission are attached hereto as Exhibit 5; and

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Gator Bowl Boulevard re-named as "East Bay Street." Gator Bowl Boulevard extending from A. Philip Randolph Blvd. to Commodore Point Expressway at the base of the Hart Bridge is hereby re-named to "East Bay Street" by which name such street and physical location shall be hereafter known and designated. A copy of the map of "East Bay Street" is attached hereto as Exhibit 6.

Section 2. Legislative Services Division directed to forward a copy to the Planning and Development Department and the Public Works Department. The Chief of Legislative Services is directed to send a copy of this legislation once enacted to the Planning and Development Department, Addressing Unit, and the Public Works Department for processing, implementation, and coordination
