AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021 FUNDS (ORIGINALLY APPROPRIATED BY ORDINANCE 2022-513-E) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,490,322 FROM THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN - CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN - CONTRACT GARBAGE AND RECYCLING ACCOUNT TO OFFSET THE ESTIMATED IMPACT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 BUDGET RESULTING FROM THE 2022 RATE REVIEW OF TWO RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE CONTRACT HAULERS, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 23-032; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

(C) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$6,490,322 in American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (the "ARP Act") funds originally appropriated by Ordinance 2022-513-E from the

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American Rescue Plan - Contingency account to the American Rescue Plan - Contract Garbage and Recycling account to offset the estimated fiscal year 2022-2023 budget impact resulting from the 2022 rate review of two residential solid waste contract haulers.

Section 2. The purpose of the appropriation in Purpose. Section 1 is to provide funding to offset estimated increased contractual costs arising from the 2022 rate review of the residential solid waste contracts with Waste Pro of Florida, Inc. and Waste Management Inc. of Florida. The Rate Review Committee "Committee") was formed in 2022 to conduct this review in accordance with Section 382.309, Ordinance Code. The Committee made a number of recommendations relative to the contracts with each hauler including adjustments to the base rate component and projected expenses, a mark-up on gross profit margins, setting of fuel usage caps, and updates to the premises count for each contract as outlined in Exhibit 2 attached hereto. These changes amount to an estimated increase to the Waste Management Inc. of Florida contract in the amount of \$2,781,251 and an increase to the Waste Pro of Florida, Inc. contract in the estimated amount of \$3,709,071 for a total estimated impact to the fiscal year 2022-2023 budget of \$6,490,322.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
