The Rate Review Committee recommends the following for Waste Management Inc. of Florida: a base rate component paid for each premise of \$14.00 effective October 1, 2022; projected expenses of \$11,073,729; mark-up of 18% as gross profit margin; estimated income before taxes of \$1,993,271; fuel usage caps for the next year for 351,287 gallons; premise count adjustment for the contract at October 1, 2022, and restated contract language within the agreement to reflect changes.
