Terms established by the Council Rate Review Process

- 1. The Base Rate Component had been set on October 1, 2021 to \$10.65 and continued at such rate through September 30, 2022. Such base rate component shall be adjusted commencing October 1, 2022 to \$14.00, and, shall be adjusted thereafter, if necessary, pursuant to the Agreement.
- 2. The fuel cap numbers shall be 351,287 gallons for fiscal year 2022/2023.
- 3. Effective October 1, 2022, 26 residential premises will be deducted from the September 30, 2022 premise count to determine the beginning number for Service Area I. The ending number of Residential Premises per the September 30, 2022 invoice was 77,165.
- 4. As disposal sites change, travel times may change and compensation may increase or decrease as a result. The City and the Contractor agree that the hourly rate per route is deemed to be \$123.00 from October 1, 2022, through September 30, 2023, if compensation should need to be adjusted for a change in Disposal Site.
- 5. If and when the Mayor declares a Storm Emergency event, the City agrees to pay the Contractor \$127.50 per ton for collection of Storm Yard Waste, as stipulated and adjusted pursuant to the agreement.
