Section 2. Carryover. The funds appropriated in this Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2023-2024.

Section 3. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to transfer \$625,395.25 to the Information Technologies Specialized Equipment account to allow the City to continue its Enterprise Security Video Camera Solution. The funds will be used to purchase upgraded camera technology equipment, to replace nonfunctioning camera equipment (including network infrastructure), and to install/upgrade security-related hardware. These funds were unencumbered at the end of fiscal year 2021-2022 after unintentionally being omitted from Schedule AF "Capital Outlay Expenditures Not Lapsed" in Ordinance 2021-504-E. Any funds remaining unspent at the end of this fiscal year will be listed on Schedule AF in the proposed fiscal year 2023-2024 budget.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
