AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$400,000.00 FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE FOR VICTIMS OF CRIME (THE "GRANT"), TO FUND THE 2022 JAX VICTIM SERVICES GRANT, A NEW ITERATION OF THE ACCESSJAX COMMUNITY COLLABORATION PROJECT, TO BE USED FOR IMPROVING AND EXPANDING THE AVAILABILITY OF ACCESSIBLE VICTIM-CENTERED, TRAUMA-INFORMED 12 13 SERVICES FOR CERTAIN VICTIMS OF CRIME, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 23-018; PROVIDING FOR 14 15 CARRYOVER OF FUNDS; AUTHORIZING A SOCIAL SERVICES SPECIALIST POSITION WITHIN THE 16 17 JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE, AS INITIATED BY R.C. 23-050; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION 19 20 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER AGREEMENTS WITH TWO OF THE CITY'S SUB-GRANTEES, OPPORTUNITY 21 22 DEVELOPMENT, INC. D/B/A CENTER FOR INDEPENDENT LIVING JACKSONVILLE AND HUBBARD HOUSE, INC., FOR THE PROVISION OF SERVICES FOR THE ACCESSJAX COMMUNITY COLLABORATION PROJECT; INVOKING THE 26 EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.107(G), ORDINANCE CODE, 27 TO ALLOW FOR DIRECT CONTRACTS WITH CENTER FOR 28 INDEPENDENT LIVING JACKSONVILLE AND HUBBARD 29 HOUSE, INC.; WAIVING SECTION 118.107 (NONPROFITS 30 TO RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH A COMPETITIVE 31 EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), ORDINANCE CODE;

PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE PARKS, 1 RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT, 2 3 SOCIAL SERVICES DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE 4 DATE. 5 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: 6 7 Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2022-2023 fiscal year, 8 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated 9 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) 10 listed in subsection (b): (B.T. 23-018 attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by 11 12 this reference) 13 (a) Appropriated from: See B.T. 23-018 \$400,000.00 14 15 (b) Appropriated to: \$400,000.00 See B.T. 23-018 16 Explanation of Appropriation 17 (C) The funding above is an appropriation of grant funds from 18 the U.S. Department of Justice, Office for Victims of Crime 19 20 (the "Grant"), to fund the 2022 JAX Victim Services Grant, 21 a new iteration of the AccessJax Community Collaboration 22 project ("AccessJax"), for the purpose of improving and expanding the availability of accessible victim-centered, 23 24 trauma-informed services to certain victims of crime. The 25 funds will be disbursed to three sub-grantees providing 26 services in support of this project as follows: (1) 27 \$199,811.96 to Opportunity Development, Inc. d/b/a Center for Independent Living Jacksonville ("CIL Jax"), (2) 2.8 29 \$66,957.04 to Hubbard House, Inc., and (3) \$128,781.00 to the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office. The remaining \$4,450.00 30 will be retained by the Social Services Division to cover 31

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travel expenses related to the project. The Grant period commenced on October 1, 2022 and continues through September 30, 2024. No local match is required.

Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 4 Section 2. Section 1 is to fund the 2022 JAX Victim Services Grant for 5 development of a new iteration of AccessJax. The primary purpose of 6 7 the JAX Victim Services Grant is to fund programs that remove barriers that may prevent individuals from reporting crimes and accessing 8 9 supportive services when they are harmed. This new iteration of 10 AccessJax is aimed at improving and expanding the availability of accessible victim-centered, trauma-informed services for crime 11 victims who are disabled, deaf, hard-of-hearing, limited English 12 proficient, blind, and/or visually impaired. This project is a 13 14 collaboration between the City (as the primary grantee of the Grant) and three sub-grantees: the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office, CIL Jax, 15 and Hubbard House, Inc. A copy of the 2022 OVC FY 2022 Enhancing 16 17 Access to Victims Services Grant Award Letter (Federal Grant Award No. 15POVC-22-GK-04371-NONF) is attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and 18 incorporated herein by this reference (the "Grant"). 19

20 Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated by this 21 Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to September 30, 2024.

Section 4. Authorization of Position. There is hereby authorized the Social Services Specialist position in the Jacksonville Sherrif's Office as more fully described in R.C. 23-050, attached hereto as Exhibit 3 and incorporated herein by this reference.

27 Section 5. Agreements Approved and Execution Authorized. 28 There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the 29 Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, 30 for and on behalf of the City, an agreement with Opportunity 31 Development, Inc. d/b/a Center for Independent Living Jacksonville

in a not-to-exceed amount of \$199,811.96, and an agreement with 1 Hubbard House, Inc. in a not-to-exceed amount of \$66,957.04 for the 2 3 provision of services in support of AccessJax in substantially the same form attached hereto as **Exhibit 4** and incorporated herein by 4 5 this reference and in accordance with the Budget and Budget Narrative attached hereto as Exhibit 5 and with the terms and conditions of the 6 7 The agreements may include such additions, deletions and Grant. 8 changes as may be reasonable, necessary and acceptable to the Mayor, 9 or his designee, with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced 10 by execution of the Agreement by the Mayor, or his designee; provided however, no modification to the agreements may increase the financial 11 12 obligations or liability of the City to an amount in excess of the amount stated in each agreement or decrease the duties and oblgiations 13 of CIL or Hubbard House, Inc., respectively, as stated in the 14 agreements, and any such modifications shall be technical only and 15 shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the 16 17 Office of General Counsel. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes having no 18 financial impact to the City, changes required for compliance with 19 20 the terms and conditions of the Grant and/or applicable federal rules, 21 regulations or policies, and any other non-substantive changes that 22 do not substantively increase the duties and responsibilities of the 23 City under the provisions of the agreements.

24 Section 6. Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.107(g), 25 Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to enter into direct 26 agreements, as authorized herein, with Opportunity Development, Inc. 27 d/b/a Center for Independent Living Jacksonville and Hubbard House, 28 Inc. for the provision of services in support of AccessJax. Pursuant 29 to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is 30 exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or 31

services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within the authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, *Ordinance Code*, shall remain in full force and effect.

Waiver of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive 5 Section 7. funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 6 7 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code. The provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through 8 9 a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), 10 Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for direct contracts with CIL Jax and Hubbard House, Inc. The City 11 finds that both non-profit organizations are uniquely situated to 12 provide services in support of AccessJax as they already have the 13 personnel and infrastructure in place to provide the services. 14

15 Section 8. Oversight. The Parks, Recreation and Community 16 Services Department, Social Services Division, shall oversee and 17 administer the project described herein.

18 Section 9. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 19 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 20 without the Mayor's signature.
