Requesting to decrease maximum indebtedness of the direct appropriation contract between the City of Jacksonville and Bridges to the Cure, LLC from \$865,000 to \$360,417 and reallocate remaining funds of \$504,583 to The Potter's House Community Development Empowering Center, Inc.; thereby increasing its Cure Violence contract's maximum indebtedness to \$1,369,583, no term change. The Bridges to the Cure, LLC FY2023 contract terms will be amended FROM October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023 TO October 1, 2022 through February 28, 2023. With the funding increase, The Potter's House Community Development Empowering Center, Inc. will expand services and continue implementation of the Cure Violence model in Northwest and North Jacksonville effective March 1, 203 through September 30, 2023. Additionally, requesting that the amended Bridges to the Cure, LLC contract contain the standard termination for convenience clause.
