impacted precinct boundaries and renumbering of associated precincts 1 in the City of Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida, to wit: City 2 3 Council District 2, City Council District 3, City Council District 7, City Council District 8, City Council District 9, City Council 4 District 10, City Council District 11, City Council District 12, and 5 City Council District 14, as reflected in the individual Council 6 7 District maps attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**. The precinct boundaries 8 for City Council Districts approved by Ordinance 2022-384-E not 9 impacted by the court order are not changing, to wit: City Council 10 District 1, City Council District 4, City Council District 5, City Council District 6, and City Council District 13. The Supervisor of 11 Elections and the Council Secretary are hereby authorized and directed 12 13 to include the boundary changes on file in their respective offices.

Because of the recent judicial decision, the nature of the emergency is that the alteration 28 29 of the boundaries and precinct locations must be mapped and the 30 impacted citizens notified prior to the upcoming March 2023 elections.
