Bill Summary: The bill appropriates \$675,693.56 from the Office of Economic Development – Professional Services account and \$215,474 from Industry Development Fund Balance to the Equal Business Employment Opportunity Office in the Procurement Division of the Finance and Administration Department.

Background Information: Pursuant to Ordinance 2021-117-E, the Jacksonville Small and Emerging Business program's Access to Capital Program has been shifted from the Office of Economic Development to the Equal Business Opportunity Office in the Procurement Division. This bill shifts the operational funding for the program from the Office of Economic Development's budget to the EBO budget, and also appropriates \$215,474 in prior year unappropriated revenues from fund balance to the Access to Capital program for future use.

Policy Impact Area: Access to Capital Program operations.

Fiscal Impact: The bill appropriates \$675,693.56 from the OED budget and \$215,474 in unappropriated program revenues to the EBO Office budget.
