Bill Summary: This legislation will appropriate \$12,060,074 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to the City of Jacksonville for a new one-time grant called the Home Investment Partnerships Grant American Rescue Plan.

Background Information: In September 2021, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development announced the allocation of \$12,060,074 to the City of Jacksonville for a new one-time grant called the Home Investment Partnerships Grant American Rescue Plan (HOME-ARP). These HOME-ARP funds are in addition to the regular FY2021 HOME formula allocation. The purpose of HOME-ARP funds is to provide homelessness assistance and supportive services through several eligible activities. HOME-ARP funding gives jurisdictions significant new resources to address homelessness assistance needs by creating affordable housing or non-congregate shelter units and providing tenant-based rental assistance or supportive services. The funding that the city receives will be used to support the construction of affordable housing units.
