Type of Action: Authorizing execution of amended waste hauler contract; designation of oversight agency

Bill Summary: The bill authorizes execution of a fourth amended waste hauler contract between the City and Waste Pro of Florida Inc. for solid waste, yard waste and recyclables collection services. It establishes the mark-up rate on expenses and designates the Solid Waste Division of the Public Works Department as the oversight agency for the contract.

NOTE: see companion bill 2022-18 for appropriation of contract funding.

Background Information: The City originally entered into a waste hauler contract with Waste Pro in 2013, which was subsequently amended in 2014, 2017 and 2020. Following a full rate review by the Rate Review Committee, the revised contract provides for the following terms:

- The base rate per premises will increase from \$14.66 to \$19.01 effective October 1, 2022.
- The mark-up rate is 18% on operating expenses before profit, interest expenses and corporate taxes
- The fuel cap will be 535,100 gallons for FY22-23
- The premises count effective October 1, 2022 will be 79,400
- The travel time hourly rate per route is \$136.74 for FY22-23
- If and when a storm emergency event is declared the rate for storm yard waste collection is \$153.89 per ton

Fiscal Impact: Ordinance 2022-18 appropriates \$3,709,071 for additional contract costs
