**Bill Summary:** The bill reappropriates \$504,583 in Cure Violence program funding from Bridges to the Cure, LLC to The Potter's House Community Development Empowering Center, Inc. It approves an amendment to the Bridges to the Cure contract to shorten the contract end date from September 20, 2023 to February 28, 2023 and decrease the contract's maximum indebtedness amount from \$865,000 to \$360,417. It approves an amendment to the Potter's House contract to expand its service area in Northwest Jacksonville and increases the contract's maximum indebtedness from \$865,000 to \$1,369,583. The Office of Grants and Compliance is designated as the City's oversight agency for the contract.

**Background Information:** The purpose of the re-appropriation is to terminate the Cure Violence service provision contract with Bridges to the Cure, LLC as of February 2023 and to transfer those funds for the remainder of the fiscal year to The Potter's House to expand its contractual scope of service from its current Westside site to cover the former Bridges to the Cure service area in North and Northwest Jacksonville.

Policy Impact Area: Cure Violence program

**Fiscal Impact:** The bill reappropriates \$504,583 in Cure Violence program funding from one service provider to another for the remainder of this fiscal year.

**Analyst:** Clements
