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## ORDINANCE 2023-45

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND S.O.C.K. OUTSTANDING STUDENTS (S.O.S.) ACADEMY, INC. FOR CHARTER MIDDLE SCHOOL, TO ALLOW FOR THE CONTINUED LEASE OF A PORTION OF THE MARY LENA GIBBS COMMUNITY CENTER COMPLEX, LOCATED AT 6974 WILSON BOULEVARD, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32210 (THE "PREMISES"), BY S.O.C.K. OUTSTANDING STUDENTS (S.O.S.)ACADEMNY, INC.; WAIVING THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 126.202 (COMPETITIVE SEALED BID), PART 2 (SUPPLIES, CONTRACTUAL SERVICES AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR THE CONTINUED OPERATION OF A CHARTER MIDDLE SCHOOL AT THE PREMISES WITHOUT THE NECESSITY OF A COMPETITIVE SEALED BID; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. First Amendment to Lease Agreement Approved and Execution Authorized. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver the First Amendment to Lease Agreement Between

the City of Jacksonville and S.O.C.K. Outstanding Students (S.O.S.) Academy, Inc. for Charter Middle School, in substantially the form attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by this reference (the "First Amendment"). S.O.C.K. Outstanding Students (S.O.S.) Academy, Inc. (the "Tenant") currently leases an office, storage area, gym and a portion of the property at the Mary Lena Gibbs Community Center Complex located at Wilson 6974 Boulevard, Jacksonville, Florida 32210 (the "Premises) to operate a Duval County charter middle school. The lease, a copy of which has been placed On File in the Legislative Services Division, was approved by Ordinance 2012-228-E and provided for an initial term of ten years commencing on the first day of the school year in 2012 and expiring on the last day of the school year in 2022, with three renewal options of three years each. The First Amendment authorizes an extension of the lease term for an additional 30 years commencing on June 1, 2022 and continuing until the last day of the school year in 2052.

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Section 2. Waiver of Section 126.202 (Competitive sealed bid), (Supplies, Contractual Services Part 2 and Capital Improvements), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code. Section 126.202 (Competitive sealed bid), Part 2 (Supplies, Contractual Services and Capital Improvements), Chapter (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, is hereby waived to allow S.O.C.K. Outstanding Students (S.O.S.) Academy, Inc. (the "Tenant") to continue to offer a charter middle school at the Premises without the necessity of a competitive sealed bid. This waiver is sought because the Tenant has been providing quality education to middle school students since 2001.

Section 3. Oversight Department. The Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department shall oversee administration of the Lease described herein.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become
