AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,000,000 FROM THE METROPOLITAN PARK MAINTENANCE FUND (11304) FUND BALANCE TO BE USED FOR ENGINEERING AND DESIGN SERVICES FOR RENOVATIONS TO METROPOLITAN PARK, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 23-025; AMENDING THE 2023-2027 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2022-505-E TO REFLECT THIS APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM THE METROPOLITAN PARK MAINTENANCE FUND (11304) FUND BALANCE TO THE METROPOLITAN PARK PROJECT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

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The funding above is an appropriation of revenue from the Metropolitan Park Maintenance Fund (11304) fund balance to pay for engineering and design services for renovations to Metropolitan Park. The Metropolitan Park Maintenance and Improvements Fund (the "Fund"), established in Section 111.120, Ordinance Code, is a permanent trust fund for all revenues received by the City in connection with admission fees for special events, rentals, dock slip rentals, equipment and service charges, and other funds from activities and events conducted or authorized by the City in Metropolitan Park.

Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 2. Section 1 is to provide funds to procure engineering and design services for renovations to Metropolitan Park. The intent is to transform the park, which is an important riverfront site, into a destination venue for recreation, concerts, and flexible space activities. The anticipated improvements to Metropolitan Park are expected to increase walkability and accessibility to a myriad of services such as retail, inviting nightlife, increased residential living, and to provide visitors and citizens access to waterfront park amenities. A contractor will be selected through a Request for Proposals process. The successful contractor who is awarded this project will be responsible to facilitate extensive public engagement and input through a series of design charettes as part of the required deliverables for the project. This appropriation aligns with the requirements of Section 111.120, Ordinance Code, which states expenditures from the Fund may be used for maintenance and improvements to Metropolitan Park and its various facilities.

Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2022-505-E, adopting the 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is

Metropolitan Park Maintenance Fund (11304) fund balance to the Metropolitan Park project to pay for engineering and design services for renovations to Metropolitan Park as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet attached hereto as Exhibit 2 incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay completion of the project.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section.
