Bill Summary: This bill appoints Chandler A. Cole, to the Building Codes Adjustment Board, replacing Tamara G. Baker, for a first full-term ending September 30, 2025.

Background Information: The Building Codes Adjustment Board is established pursuant to Chapter 56, *Ordinance Code*, and charged to study building codes and recommend to Council needed amendments thereto as may be found necessary or desirable; hear and decide building code enforcement appeals; and authorize building code variances where authorized by law. Section 56.101, *Ordinance Code*, provides that the nine members of the board are appointed by the Council.

Mr. Cole is a structural engineer for Baker Design Build and has experience in engineering design, inspections, field project management and construction in commercial, educational, municipal and residential projects. Mr. Cole holds a degree in civil engineering from Florida State University and he is a member of the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) and the Florida Structural Engineering Association (FSEA). He resides in Duval County in Council District 13.
