ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER TO KARPELES MANUSCRIPT LIBRARY INCOPORATED, A CALIFORNIA NOT PROFIT CORPORATION (THE "GRANTEE"), CORRECTIVE QUITCLAIM DEED FOR THE PURPOSE OF TERMINATING THE CITY'S EXISTING RIGHT REVERTER IN AND TO AN UNIMPROVED PARCEL OF REAL PROPERTY LOCATED ON FIRST STREET WEST BETWEEN BOULEVARD STREET AND LAURA STREET NORTH (R.E. # 070825-0000) (THE "PROPERTY"); PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Property is subject to a right of reverter created pursuant to Ordinance 1995-504-274 (the "1995 Ordinance") as set forth in that certain Special Warranty Deed recorded at Official Records Book 8240, Page 889 of the Public Records of Duval County Florida.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the 1995 Ordinance, the Property was declared surplus and conveyed to Grantee in 1995 for no consideration in connection with Grantee's operation of a nationally recognized manuscript museum on an adjoining parcel which has since permanently closed.

WHEREAS, passage of this Ordinance by the Council will terminate all of City's reversionary interest in the Property and enable Grantee to sell the property to a third party in its sole discretion for the purpose of promoting commercial infill development adjacent to

downtown.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Approval and authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver to Grantee on behalf of the City, that certain Corrective Quitclaim Deed in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and all such other documents necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purpose of this Ordinance for the purpose of terminating the City's existing right of reverter in and to the Property and enabling the Grantee to sell the property to a third party buyer free and clear of the City's reversionary interest therein for the public purpose of promoting commercial infill development adjacent to downtown.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
