Bill Summary: This bill confirms the appointment of Amy Crane to the Cultural Service Grant Program Committee, as a community representative, replacing Kimberly Morrison, for a first full-term ending December 31, 2025.

Background Information: The Cultural Service Grant Program Committee is established pursuant to Chapter 118, Part 6, *Ordinance Code*, and charged to recommend to the Cultural Council Board of Directors the organizations to be funded and the amount of the funding. Section 118.605, *Ordinance Code*, provides that the membership of the committee shall include seven individuals selected from community wide and confirmed by the City Council.

Ms. Crane is currently a Senior Program Director for the Community Foundation for Northeast Florida and she has been in that role since 2013. She has a bachelor's degree in Art History from the State University of New York, College at Oswego. She resides in Council District 13.
