\$684,572.74 grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency Hazard Mitigation Grant Program, through the State Florida, Division of Emergency Management, to fund designrelated services and activities for the McCoys Creek Greenway - McCoys Creek Boulevard Closure project (the "Project"). The grant period commenced on July 16, 2021 and continues through December 31, 2023. No local match is required.

Section 2. 9 Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 10 Section 1 is to provide funding for surveying, engineering, design, plans preparation, permitting, and bidding for the Project. 11 The Project entails closure of the McCoys Creek Boulevard right-of-way 12 to provide new open space for park improvements, including 13 pedestrian/bike paths, green space, and creek restoration. A copy 14 15 of the Modification to Subgrant Agreement Between the Division of Emergency Management and City of Jacksonville (Contract Number: 16 17 H0595) providing the terms and conditions relative to receipt and 18 expenditure of the grant funds is attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and 19 incorporated herein by this reference.

20 Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 21 2022-505-E, adopting the 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan 22 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to provide additional funding for completion of the 23 24 Project as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet 25 attached hereto as **Exhibit 3** and incorporated herein by this 26 reference. The City Council finds that deferral of this amendment 27 of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be 2.8 detrimental to the best interests of the community because such 29 deferral may result in loss of the grant funds.

30 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of 31 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the

1 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP 2 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute 3 an amendment to Ordinance 2022-505-E. In all other respects, the 4 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2022-505-E 5 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

6 Section 4. Oversight. The Public Works Department 7 shall oversee the Project and administration of the grant described 8 herein.

9 Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become
10 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
11 without the Mayor's signature.
