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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

24 Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2022-2023 fiscal year, 25 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the 26 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to 27 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation

The funding above is an appropriation of additional Emergency Rental Assistance Program (round two) (the "ERA2 Program") grant funds, made available to the City through a reallocation of ERA2 Program grant funds by the U.S. Department of the Treasury under Section 501(d), Division N, of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021 (the "Act"), in the amount of \$6,374,458.34 (the "ERA2 Funds"), of which \$4,374,458.34 will be allocated to the and Community Development Division of Housing the Neighborhoods Department and \$2,000,000 will be allocated to the Social Services Division of the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department for the provision of emergency rent and utility assistance to eliqible households in accordance with the ERA2 Program established by the Act. No local match is required.

19 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 20 Section 1 is to provide funds for emergency rent and utility 21 assistance on a short-term basis to eligible households in Duval 22 County, Florida to prevent evictions and homelessness. A portion 23 of the ERA2 Funds appropriated hereby will be allocated to the 24 Social Services Division of the Parks, Recreation and Community 25 Services Department for the provision of rent and utility 26 assistance through existing Social Services Division programs, with 27 the remainder being allocated to the Housing and Community 28 Development Division of the Neighborhoods Department for the 29 provision of rent and utility assistance through existing Housing and Community Development Division programs. The Act provides that 30 31 ERA2 Funds may be used for payment of rent, rent arrears, utilities

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and home energy costs, utilities and home energy costs arrears, and 1 2 other expenses related to housing incurred by eligible households due, directly or indirectly, to the COVID-19 pandemic, between 3 March 13, 2020 through September 30, 2025. Distribution of the 4 5 ERA2 Funds and local administration of the ERA2 Program shall be conducted in compliance with the Act for expenses incurred by 6 7 eligible households in Duval County through September 30, 2023. Copies of the award notification from the U.S. Department of the 8 9 Treasury and the Award Terms and Conditions are attached hereto as 10 Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 3. Oversight Department. The Social 11 Services 12 Division of the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department, and the Housing and Community Development Division of 13 the Neighborhoods Department shall oversee the administration and 14 15 distribution of their respective allocations of ERA2 Funds in accordance with the Act. 16

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
