The funding above comprises an appropriation of \$27,678.57 in additional funds received from the State of Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services State Financial Assistance Recipient Agreement (FDACS Contract #29364) (the "Agreement"), and deappropriating a transfer of \$3,330.00 from Mosquito Control State Subfund 00112 fund balance to be used for Mosquito Control Division operational expenses.
