Section 1. License Agreement Approved and Execution
Authorized. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee,
and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and
deliver, for and on behalf of the City, that certain License Agreement

Between the City of Jacksonville and Lutheran Services Florida, Inc. 1 for Head Start Program at Moncrief Senior Center for Comprehensive 2 3 Childhood Development in substantially the form placed Revised On File with the Legislative Services Division (the "Agreement"). Said 4 Agreement authorizes Lutheran Services Florida, Inc. (the "Licensee") 5 use of and access to the Moncrief Senior Center located at 5713 Teeler 6 7 Avenue, Jacksonville, Florida 32208 for a term beginning upon execution of the License Agreement and continuing through July 30, 8 9 2033, with one five-year extension option, for operation of an Early 10 Childhood Development Center to provide Head Start programming. The Licensee currently operates out of an apartment unit in the nearby 11 Fairway Oaks Apartments and there exists a need for additional early 12 childhood development in this area. The Licensee will provide 54 13 seats for early childhood development for low-income children and 14 15 their families residing in zip code 32208 at no cost to the families 16 or participants.

17 The Duval County Head Start Program has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$208,000 for the renovation of the Moncrief Senior 18 19 Center for use as an Early Childhood Development Center. The City has 20 agreed to contribute \$80,000 toward Americans with Disabilities Act 21 (ADA) upgrades to the facility and to satisfy the grant match 22 requirement for the award of funds to the Duval County Head Start Program. In addition, the City, through its Public Works Department, 23 24 will ensure the renovations to the property satisfy all applicable building codes as required for operation of an early learning center 25 26 and to pass zoning, fire, and Department of Children and Families 27 inspections.

28 Section 2. Further Authorizations. The Agreement may 29 include such additions, deletions and changes as may be reasonable, 30 necessary and acceptable to the Mayor, or his designee, with such 31 inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the Agreement

by the Mayor, or his designee; provided however, no modification to 1 the Agreement may increase the financial obligations or liability of 2 the City to an amount in excess of the amount stated in the Agreement 3 or decrease the duties and oblgiations of the Licensee as stated in 4 5 the Agreement, and any such modifications shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the 6 7 Office of General Counsel. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes having no 8 9 financial impact to the City, changes required for compliance with 10 the terms and conditions of any grant funding received by the City or Licensee for the Head Start programming to be offered at the 11 Moncrief Senior Center, and any other non-substantive changes that 12 do not substantively increase the duties and responsibilities of the 13 City under the provisions of the Agreement. 14

Section 3. Oversight Department. The Parks, Recreation and
Community Services Department shall oversee administration of the
Agreement and project described herein.

18 Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 19 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 20 without the Mayor's signature.
