Department of Transportation ("FDOT"), to establish the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office Impaired Driving Enforcement Project. The grant period commenced on July 1, 2022 and continues through September 30, 2023. No local match is required.

Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 2. Section 1 is to utilize grant funding from NHTSA, made available through FDOT as a Highway Traffic Safety Program subgrant, to establish the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office Impaired Driving Enforcement Project (the "Project"). The purpose of the Project is to decrease the percentage of impaired-driving fatalities and crashes occurring in Duval County and to improve the City of Jacksonville's statistical ranking measured under the Florida Strategic Highway Safety Plan. Funds will be used for a variety of Project expenses including overtime salaries and benefits for law enforcement officers, running lights for unmarked vehicles, and maintaining a message board. A copy of the Subgrant for Highway Traffic Safety Funds, outlining the terms and conditions relative to the grant and use of the grant funds, has been placed On File with the Legislative Services Division.

Section 3. Oversight and Reporting. The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office, Patrol Support Division, shall oversee administration of the grant and Project described herein.
