6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING GRANT FUNDS IN THE  
7 AMOUNT OF \$85,000.00 FROM THE NATIONAL HIGHWAY  
8 TRAFFIC SAFETY ADMINISTRATION, THROUGH THE  
9 FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, TO  
10 ESTABLISH THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE  
11 IMPAIRED DRIVING ENFORCEMENT PROJECT, AS  
12 INITIATED BY B.T. 23-035; PROVIDING FOR  
13 OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE,  
14 PATROL SUPPORT DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE  
15 DATE.

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17 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

18 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,  
19 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
20 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
21 listed in subsection (b):

28 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

29 The funding above represents an appropriation of grant  
30 funds from the National Highway Traffic Safety  
31 Administration ("NHTSA"), through the State of Florida

1 Department of Transportation ("FDOT"), to establish the  
2 Jacksonville Sheriff's Office Impaired Driving Enforcement  
3 Project. The grant period commenced on July 1, 2022 and  
4 continues through September 30, 2023. No local match is  
5 required.

6 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
7 Section 1 is to utilize grant funding from NHTSA, made available  
8 through FDOT as a Highway Traffic Safety Program subgrant, to  
9 establish the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office Impaired Driving  
10 Enforcement Project (the "Project"). The purpose of the Project is  
11 to decrease the percentage of impaired-driving fatalities and crashes  
12 occurring in Duval County and to improve the City of Jacksonville's  
13 statistical ranking measured under the Florida Strategic Highway  
14 Safety Plan. Funds will be used for a variety of Project expenses  
15 including overtime salaries and benefits for law enforcement  
16 officers, running lights for unmarked vehicles, and maintaining a  
17 message board. A copy of the Subgrant for Highway Traffic Safety  
18 Funds, outlining the terms and conditions relative to the grant and  
19 use of the grant funds, has been placed **On File** with the Legislative  
20 Services Division.

21 **Section 3. Oversight and Reporting.** The Jacksonville  
22 Sheriff's Office, Patrol Support Division, shall oversee  
23 administration of the grant and Project described herein.

24 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
25 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
26 without the Mayor's signature.
