Bill Summary: This bill is an appropriation of \$684,572.74 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency Hazard Mitigation Grant Program, through the State Florida, Division of Emergency Management, to fund design related services and activities for the McCoys Creek Greenway – McCoys Creek Boulevard Closure project. The 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan is amended to provide funding for the project. The Public Works Department will provide oversight.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to provide funds for the McCoys Creek Greenway – McCoys Creek Boulevard Closure project. The funds will cover Phase 1 - surveying, engineering, design, plans preparation, permitting, and bidding. The project entails closure of the McCoys Creek Boulevard right-of-way to provide new open space for park improvements, including pedestrian/bike paths, green space, and creek restoration. The grant period commenced on July 16, 2021, and continues through December 31, 2023.
