ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE CITY COUNCIL'S ΑN CONCURRENCE WITH THE PROPOSED APPOINTMENT OF ANTONIO NICHOLS AS MEDICAL DIRECTOR OF DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH DUVAL COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH UNIT BY THE STATE SURGEON GENERAL PURSUANT TO SECTION 154.04, FLORIDA STATUTES, AND CONFIRMING THE JOINT APPOINTMENT OF ANTONIO NICHOLS AS MEDICAL DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH DUVAL COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH UNIT BY THE DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND THE MAYOR PURSUANT TO SECTION 29.102, ORDINANCE CODE; WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 29.102 (DIRECTOR), CHAPTER 29 (PUBLIC HEALTH UNIT), ORDINANCE CODE, THAT THE MEDICAL DIRECTOR BE AN M.D. OR A D.O. LICENSED UNDER CHAPTER 458 OR CHAPTER 459, FLORIDA STATUTES, AND HAVE MASTER'S DEGREE IN PUBLIC HEALTH; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appointment. The Council hereby confirms its concurrence with the State Surgeon General's proposed appointment of Antonio Nichols as Medical Director of the Department of Health Duval County Public Health Unit pursuant to Section 154.04, Florida Statutes, and further confirms the joint appointment of Mr. Nichols to this position by the District Administrator for the Department of Health and the Mayor pursuant to Section 29.102, Ordinance Code.

Attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** is the *curriculum vitae* of Antonio Nichols.

Section 2. Waiver of Certain Requirements in Section 29.102 (Director), Chapter 29 (Public Health Unit), Ordinance Code. requirements outlined in Section 29.102 (Director), Chapter 29 (Public Health Unit), Ordinance Code, that the Medical Director be an M.D. or a D.O. and have a Master's Degree in Public Health are hereby waived recognizing that although Mr. Nichols is not an M.D. or a D.O. and does not have the specified degree, he does possess a Master's of Business Administration and has substantial, relevant professional experience in public health management and training in public health administration. Mr. Nichols began his tenure with the Department of Health Duval County in August 2005 as an Operations and Management Consultant I. He subsequently served in a number of increasingly important and impactful roles with the Department, including as Revenue Program Administrator, Finance Director, and Assistant Director of Administration and Operations, which ultimately culminated in his appointment to serve as Interim Medical Director for the Department of Health Duval County Public Health Unit in April 2022.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
