ORDINANCE 2023-188

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING A \$2,000,000 GRANT FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, FOR THE MAYOR'S VIOLENCE REDUCTION CENTER ("MVRC") COMMUNITY-BASED VIOLENCE INTERVENTION AND PREVENTION INITIATIVE ("CVIPI"), AS INITIATED BY B.T. 23-043; AUTHORIZING POSITIONS, AS INITIATED BY R.C. 23-095; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, AN AGREEMENT WITH JUSTICE & SECURITY STRATEGIES, INC.; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, AN AGREEMENT WITH FAMILY FOUNDATIONS OF NORTHEAST FLORIDA, INC.; INVOKING THE EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.107(G) (EXEMPTIONS), PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO DIRECT CONTRACT WITH JUSTICE SECURITY STRATEGIES, INC. AND FOUNDATIONS OF NORTHEAST FLORIDA, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF SERVICES FOR THE MVRC CVIPI; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2022-2023 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents a grant in the amount of \$2,000,000 from the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, to support the Mayor's Violence Reduction Center ("MVRC") Community-Based Violence Intervention and Prevention Initiative ("CVIPI") for the purpose of crime prevention and intervention and improving public safety in Duval County. No local match is required. The grant period commenced on October 1, 2022 and continues through September 30, 2025, with opportunity for a no cost extension by the grantor.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to fund several positions within the Grants and Contract Compliance Division to support the MVRC CVIPI and to procure contractual services for the MVRC CVIPI as more specifically described herein. Programs funded by this grant serve to interrupt the transmission of violence in communities most affected by violent crime. The City will utilize the grant funds to align intervention activities in a community that has documented a large number of homicides and whose members have been historically underserved, marginalized, and adversely affected by inequality. In addition, the

MVRC CVIPI is designed to align community violence intervention assets at a central hub, increasing protective factors and reducing shootings in one of the deadliest communities in the country.

The MVRC CVIPI will also serve to expand and enhance the City's current violent crime intervention strategy, Cure Violence. This federal grant funding will unify the three existing Cure Violence Jacksonville sites and other community-wide violence intervention efforts at the MVRC. This effort will also link individual victims of transgenerational violence with assessments, referrals for wraparound services, education, workforce training and placement, and follow-up services for up to one year. Participants will learn family-sustaining lifestyles and vocational skills. Copies of the Grant Award Letter (Award Number 15PBJA-22-GG-04710-CVIP), Award Conditions, and Budget Narrative outlining the terms and conditions and uses of the grant funds are attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 3. Approval of Positions. There are hereby approved the positions more fully described in R.C. 23-095, attached hereto as Exhibit 3 and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 4. Approval and Authorization to Execute Agreement Between the City and Justice & Security Strategies, Inc. The Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation ("JS&S, Inc."). Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver an agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Justice & Security Strategies, Inc. in a not-to-exceed amount of \$450,000, for the provision of services to the MVRC CVIPI as more particularly described in Exhibit 4, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. agreement may include such additions, deletions and changes as may be reasonable, necessary and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, including any amendments thereto as necessary to comply with the terms and conditions of the grant or to extend the agreement term

in conjunction with any extensions to the grant term, as may be acceptable to the Mayor, or his designee, with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the agreement or applicable amendment thereto by the Mayor, or his designee; provided however, no modifications or amendments to the agreement may increase the financial obligations or liability of the City to an amount in excess of the amount stated in the agreement or decrease the duties and obligations of JS&S, Inc., and any such modifications shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the Office of General Counsel and the Office of Risk Management for appropriate insurance and indemnification terms. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes having no financial impact to the City and any other non-substantive changes that do not substantively increase the duties and responsibilities of the City under the provisions of the agreement.

and Authorization Section 5. Approval to Execute an Agreement Between the City and Family Foundations of Northeast Florida, Inc. ("Family Foundations"). The Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver an agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Family Foundations of Northeast Florida, Inc. in a not-to-exceed amount of \$568,331, for the provision of services in support of the MVRC CVIPI and in furtherance of expansion of the Cure Violence initiative as described in Exhibit 5, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. The agreement may include such additions, deletions and changes as may be reasonable, necessary and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, including any amendments thereto as necessary to comply with the terms and conditions of the grant or to extend the agreement term in conjunction with any extensions to the grant term, as may be acceptable to the Mayor, or his designee,

with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the agreement or applicable amendment thereto by the Mayor, or his designee; provided however, no modifications or amendments to the Agreement may increase the financial obligations or liability of the City to an amount in excess of the amount stated in the agreement or decrease the duties and obligations of Family Foundations, and any such modifications shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the Office of General Counsel and the Office of Risk Management for appropriate insurance and indemnification terms. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes having no financial impact to the City and any other non-substantive changes that do not substantively increase the duties and responsibilities of the City under the provisions of the agreement.

Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.107(g), Section 6. Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to enter into direct agreements with Justice & Security Strategies, Inc. and Family Foundations of Northeast Florida, Inc., for the purpose of providing services to the MVRC CVIPI. Both entities were identified in the City's grant application as vendors providing services in support of this initiative. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically described the authorizing legislation in appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 7. Oversight Department. The Grants and Contract Compliance Division shall oversee administration of the grant and program described herein.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
