DISCLAIMING

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Closure and Abandonment. The drainage easements established in Map Book E, pages 71 through 86, in the official public records of Duval County, Florida, all lying within a portion of the Equinox East Plat, as recorded in Plat Book 78, pages 27 through 35, of the current public records of Duval County, Florida, located in Council District 11, a depiction and description of which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference, are hereby closed and abandoned and/or disclaimed as drainage easements at the request of Forestar (USA) Real Estate Group Inc. (the "Applicant"). The Applicant paid a total application fee of \$6,328.00 (four easement closures with encroachments), which has been deposited into the General Fund. This closure request was reviewed and approved by the various city, state, and other agencies that might have an

interest in the drainage easements and there were no objections to the Applicant's request.

Section 2. Purpose. The Applicant owns numerous parcels in the area of A.C. Skinner Parkway near Key Lime Drive that are subject to these drainage easements (see R.E. No. 138439-1310 for locational purposes) and is requesting the closure for the construction of a townhome development, subject to the conditions set forth herein.

abandonment by the City of its interests in the subject drainage easements is contingent upon Applicant's execution and delivery to the City of a Hold Harmless Covenant, in substantially the same form attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. Accordingly, the closure and abandonment of the aforesaid drainage easements shall not be recorded in the official public records until execution and delivery to the City by the Applicant of the required Hold Harmless Covenant.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
