Explanation of Appropriation: (C)

> The funding above represents an appropriation of \$1,250,000 (\$1,100,000 from the Traffic Signalization - Countywide Project and \$150,000 from the Countywide Intersection Imp - Intersection Project) to the Traffic Signal (New) New Berlin Road and Cedar Point Road Project.

Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 2. Section 1 is to transfer funds from the Traffic Signalization -Countywide and Countywide Intersection Imp - Intersection Projects to the Traffic Signal (New) New Berlin Road and Cedar Point Road Project (the "Project") for completion of the Project in a timely manner. The Project will entail installation of a new traffic signal at the intersection of New Berlin Road and Cedar Point Road and realignment of the intersection for safer geometry. In addition, the Project will entail completion of necessary roadwork and drainage improvements that have recently been identified. Traffic studies conducted at this intersection reveal that a new signal will improve traffic operations during the morning and afternoon peak hours. It is anticipated that this new signal will reduce traffic congestion and improve commuter drive time.

Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance Section 3. 2022-505-E, adopting the 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reflect the transfer of funding from the Traffic Signalization - Countywide and Countywide Intersection Imp -Intersection Projects to the Traffic Signal (New) New Berlin Road and Cedar Point Road Project, as more fully described in the Project Information Sheets attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev CIP Sheets, March 6, 2023 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that

the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay completion of the Project.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2022-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2022-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
